Malahat SkyWalk is a fully immersive nature, adventure, hospitality experience and Vancouver Island's premier outdoor attraction. Considered one of the top three places to visit in and around Victoria, BC, the Skywalk begins with an elevated TreeWalk, high amongst a mature arbutus and Douglas-fir forest. The star of the attraction is the 10-storey architecturally stunning Spiral Tower, which offers sweeping and unobstructed views of the rugged coastal rainforest, shimmering Pacific waters, majestic mountains, and islands in the distance. Designed with accessibility in mind, Malahat SkyWalk welcomes visitors of all ages and abilities. The attraction combines thoughtful design and innovation with environmental stewardship, creating a memorable nature-based experience that can be enjoyed year-round.
